#### Lent/Triduum 2020

Next year, *Ash Wednesday* falls on February 26.

After wide consultation, Bishop Zinkula has decided to celebrate the *Rite of Election* at St. Patrick Church in Iowa City again next year, on the First Sunday of Lent (March 1) at 3:00 p.m. This way, the entire diocese can gather together for this important liturgy.

The plans for celebrating the *Chrism Mass* are still being determined.

The Triduum falls on Thursday, April 9 through Sunday, April 12 – with the *Easter Vigil* falling on the night of Saturday, April 11. On that night, the earliest that the Vigil may begin is 8:30pm.
