Costume: Spandex leotard with embroidered lace overlay & cap sleeves; attached organdy skirt with layers of mesh

Hair: Styled in a high bun, with headpiece secured to dancer's RIGHT side of bun

-Ballet shoes

-Beige or skin colored tights

Make Up: The amount of stage makeup for your dancer is completely up to you as a family. At minimum we suggest red or dark pink lipstick and pink blush. If your dancer enjoys make up, a full stage makeup look (foundation, eye shadow, eyeliner, mascara etc) is great too!
