AGREEMENT AND CONSENT

I, _____, understand that part of the R.C.I.A. process is investigating into the status of couples (i.e. validity of their current marriage) so as to provide an unencumbered entrance into the Church; that depending on a couple’s situation, it may not be permissible to provide the Sacraments of Initiation; and that marriage is an important aspect of the deepening Christian conversion, and a sacrament that is not to be separated from the sacraments of initiation for couples.

I agree that I will provide the required documents below to the Office of Religious Education no later than the second week of December.

1. A recent baptismal certificate dated **no more than 6 months** from today’s date.
 - a. You will need to contact the parish (doesn’t matter the country) where you were baptized to request a new one with notations.
2. First Holy Communion certificate (if applicable).
3. If married, civil marriage certificate and if applicable Church marriage certificate.
4. If you have been married before, civilly or in the Church, please provide all previous marriage(s) certificate(s) and the final divorce decree and/or declaration of nullity from the Catholic Church.
5. If you’re married or cohabiting, the same documents are required from your spouse, and if applicable, spouse’s Confirmation certificate.
