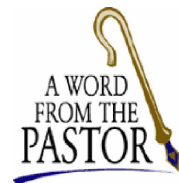

Attentiveness to God's Presence and Will is what Jesus wants for us, his people. In the first reading from Genesis (18:1-10) Abraham is running about doing the many details of hospitality even in the heat of the day. For this hospitality, Sarah and Abraham are rewarded with the promise of a long awaited son. Today, in the Gospel, is the familiar story of Jesus going to the house of Martha and Mary. Martha does a good thing: she "welcomed Him." Martha begins the work of serving and Mary is seated at the feet of Jesus. Martha becomes "burdened with much serving." Then, suddenly Martha, is telling THE LORD what to do, "Tell her to help me." The Lord, in turn, points out that she is "anxious and worried about many things." Jesus says that, "There is need of only one thing." Maybe the one thing is to be attentive to Jesus. If He wants us to be busy about many things, then we can be joyful in doing what is His will. If he wants us to sit quietly and pay attention to the working of the Spirit within us at a given point, then we can have a deep joy because we are aware of His Presence and doing His will. Hopefully, we can work more consistently at doing the one thing. May we get better at choosing "the better part": listening and doing God's will for us at any given time.
