Today, we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. We hear from Mark's gospel as Jesus institutes the Eucharist: "Take it; this is my body..." Whenever we receive Communion, Christ's Body, we also receive the Father and the Spirit because God is acting upon us to sanctify us in His very essence which is Trinitarian. God always acts as three persons united as one. We offer everything to the Father, through the Son, who lives and reigns with the Holy Spirit. In the Eucharistic prayer we call down the Spirit to change ordinary bread into the Body and Blood of Christ. We celebrated Pentecost just two weeks ago, the mystery of the Trinity last week and the great mystery of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ this week. We really do need the Holy Spirit to come to a deeper understanding of the Eucharist. I used the following prayer to begin Mass at Pentecost. I invite you to continue to say this prayer before you read the Bible or whenever you feel you need strength, understanding and wisdom in anyway.

V. Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful.

R. And kindle in them the fire of your love.

V. Send Forth your Spirit and they shall be created.

R. And you will renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray... Lord by the light of the Holy Spirit you have taught the hearts of your faithful. In the same Spirit help us to relish what is right and always rejoice in your consolation. We ask this through Christ our Lord. R. Amen
