I want to thank everybody who had a part in celebrating my 30th Anniversary of the priesthood, or thank you for celebrating my spiritual fatherhood. It is just amazing that I have been Pastor of St. Johns for 14 years and Sacred Heart for four years already. I really enjoyed the rectory open house with an ice cream social. Thank you for your cards and gifts. I used your gifts and added some extra to help be a "father" to some children in Haiti. There was some flooding that destroyed their crops at our poorest chapel Vieux Cayes so some of us are helping them to re-establish their food source through farming. An organization called Partners in Progress is assisting us to help them at the request of Fr. Wilfranc, the Pastor of our Twin Parish in Haiti. In today's gospel, Jairus is requesting Jesus to help his daughter. What would a good father do for his children if they were sick, at the point of dying? This father named Jairus, who was, also, a synagogue official, was willing to fall "at (Jesus') feet" and plead with him. "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." That would be rather humbling. Yet, I kind of get that when I ask people to help my children in these parishes whether it be with their spiritual needs, like teaching Faith Formation, or with their corporal needs as with my kids in Haiti, these children who are at the point of death.
