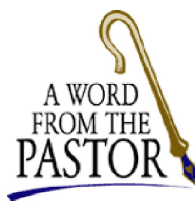

Today, in the book of Numbers, there is a commissioning for others other than Moses to receive the spirit of the Lord to be prophets. Some were on the list but did not go to the meeting place. The spirit still came upon them and Joshua asked Moses to stop them. Moses replied, "Are you jealous for my sake? Would not all the people of the Lord were prophets! Would that the Lord might bestow his spirit on them all" (Numbers 11:28b-29). In the Gospel, the disciples try to stop someone who was driving out a demon because that person did not belong to their company. Jesus told them not to stop him, "For whoever is not against us is for us" (Mark 9:40). Both Moses and Jesus in these passages seem to propose a big tent where many are welcomed and given a chance to contribute. One Catholic principle is that one should presume "good will." Do not presume that people are trying to work against us. It is kind of like the principle in democratic law: a person is innocent until proven guilty and not the other way around: guilty until proven innocent. These principles allow for more universal embrace of people. Such an attitude would encourage welcoming people as if they were brothers and sisters. This response to the Gospel would very much discourage prejudice and any hint of racism because God created us all in this his likeness and image. May our parish be a more welcoming embracing community, a kind of atmosphere that Jesus seems to encourage in this gospel!
