I have been coming here for at least 18 years, so I have gotten to know many people. Fr. Scott celebrated that wedding, one of the two Saturday evening Masses, and also went to the reception. These days he has been doing 7 of the 14 Masses on Sunday. Sunday night I had the 10:30 pm Mass, and it was the smallest crowd, but still between 100-125 people. The crowds of people wanting confession are mind blowing. Even though it is so cold there, I am still looking forward to being back with you. Fr. Tim
