MINUTES REVIEW / REVISIONS / ACCEPTANCE – March's minutes approved by consensus

CHURCH / EMMAUS HALL ROOF UPDATE – Dan McGraw

- Church's 3 roof sections need repair / replacement – warranty not available when installed
- Recommendation is to replace all sections
- **Parish Pastoral Council & Buildings & Grounds committee provided consensus for Sister Joan to proceed**
- Finance committee will discuss at April 24 meeting – consensus approval required to move forward

PASTORAL ADMINISTRATOR REMARKS – Sister Joan

- Faith Formation: K-5, ended this evening with a Pasta Dinner for families which was well attended
- Sunday, April 28, at the 8:30 Mass: Stephen Ministers will be commissioned; John Costanza is a new Stephen Minister
- CMA ends May 31st; \$42,775.94 pledged; \$4,430.06 is the shortfall, approximately \$1,000. in unpaid pledges (potential second collection in May)
- Legacy of Hope: \$11,456 has been pledged. Target is \$29,000; Campaign ends this month; in the diocese, \$1,152,017 has been pledged
- Group First Eucharist celebrations are May 4 and 18 at the 5:00pm Mass
