MINUTES REVIEW/ REVISIONS/ ACCEPTANCE – Minutes accepted

PASTORAL ADMINISTRATOR’S REMARKS –

- CMA is at 93.14% and the Appeal ends May 31st. We are \$3,489 short of our goal & there is \$779 in unpaid pledges. Second Collection May 11th may help with the shortfall.
- Bishop’s Convocation was held in Watkins Glen and Fr. Donald Senior, a Scripture scholar, was our excellent speaker.
- Faith Formation classes ended April 27th with a pasta dinner.
- 10 youngsters received First Communion on May 3rd and 8 more will on the 17th
- Discussion followed on the proposal that the parish picnic be at Sea Breeze this year rather than at a park. There was no clear resolution as pros and cons to both were mentioned. **Members are asked to check with other parishioners as to their thoughts on this.**
- Leadership Development Training Program: people from COTA and COR have been meeting since Lent with Fr. Ed Palumbos to plan a smooth transition for when Fr. Ed takes over as pastor of both parishes. The May 18th bulletin at both parishes will have the same article outlining again what is happening near the end of June.
- Updated Eric Patchke at the diocese regarding our progress on the roof project: subcommittee to check for other capital expenses to roll into a capital campaign
