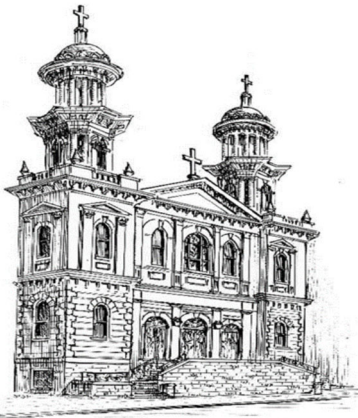

FROM FATHER CHUCK'S DESK

Happy Nevada Day! I say this in light of the holiday last Friday and in anticipation of true Nevada Day, October 31, when Nevada became a state in the United States of America in 1864. Prior to moving the holiday to the last Friday of the month a few years ago, I remember marking Nevada Day in a special way and being the only state in the Union who got Halloween off! It was kind of a fun coincidence to celebrate.

This Friday is **All Saints Day** and a holy day of obligation. We'll celebrate 3 Masses: 7:00 AM & 12:10 PM in English and 5:15 PM (bilingual). All Saints Day has been celebrated for well over a millennium, since Pope Gregory III declared it a holy day to commemorate all those "saints", known and unknown, who have entered heaven. We give thanks for the saints we celebrate by name in the Church. They give us hope and challenge us by their example of faith. We also give thanks for those who shared their faith and inspired us personally during their lives on earth. Those who have gone before us who, though not known by the Church universal, are with God and, through their lives, continue to inspire us. Saturday, November 2, is **All Souls Day** and I think appropriately overlaps with the prior day as we remember all who have died and pray for them that they may be with God in heaven. Masses for All Souls Day will be at 8:00 AM in English and at 12:00 Noon in Spanish.

As we did last year, we will have a special prayer table to remember those who have died. You are invited to place photos or other memorials on the table. We also will have a book for you to write the names of those you want remembered by our community. Please bring photos or memorials to the church to place on the table when you come for Mass. You may leave them for the month of November. If you want to get back what you bring, please be sure to put your name and contact information on it so it can be returned to you. The All Souls Novena remembrance is another way to lift up your loved ones in prayer. A donation may be made in the envelope along with writing the names of loved ones, then place it in the charity box or collection basket. We will remember all those who have gone before us throughout the month of November.

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday this week our office staff, Fr. Lucio, a member of our Parish Council and I will be attending a conference on parish leadership. The conference is entitled "Amazing Parish". In it, experts on Church organization and company leadership will share ideas and skills to help parish leadership awaken to a deeper sense of mission and to help ignite the whole parish to its role in living out its mission for the Church. I am excited about the opportunity to reflect on where we are as a parish community and the possibilities of how we might continue to grow and witness to the gospel in our city and diocese. As downtown continues to change and grow, I think this discussion is all the more vital. Please keep us in prayer as we attend this conference. May the Holy Spirit guide us as we go!

On the topic of Life & Mission, I want to thank Anne Buja for organizing our Ministry Fair and all who helped her and sat at tables Saturday evening and all day Sunday to share the news of the ministries you offer. . Quite a few of our parishioners came down to Righini Hall and signed up to be involved. You enter into discipleship in a special way through these ministries. If you signed up, you should be getting notice this week about next steps to your discipleship. Thank you for your willingness to serve and to all those who came down to the hall. Special thanks, too, to the Knights of Columbus for the delicious breakfast they offered! Please let us know if you signed up for a ministry but have not heard from anyone or if you were unable to sign up at the Ministry Fair but are interested in participating. Our parish is as alive & active as our people, so please pray about what role you will play in this discipleship and pray for one another.

¡Feliz Día de Nevada! Lo digo a la luz del viernes pasado y en previsión del verdadero Día de Nevada. Nevada se convirtió en un estado en los Estados Unidos de América el 31 de octubre de 1864. Cuando yo era niño y antes de que se trasladara el día festivo al último viernes del mes, el Día de Nevada se marcaba de manera especial pues era el único estado en la Unión que tenía el día de Halloween de descanso, era una coincidencia divertida para celebrar.

Este viernes es el Día de **Todos los Santos**, un día de obligación. Celebraremos 3 Misas: 7:00 AM y 12:10 PM en inglés y 5:15 PM bilingüe. El Día de todos los Santos se ha celebrado durante más de un milenio. El Papa Gregorio III lo declaró un día de observación para conmemorar a todos los "santos", conocidos y desconocidos, que han entrado al cielo. Damos gracias por los santos que celebramos por su nombre en la Iglesia. Nos dan esperanza y nos desafían con su ejemplo de fe. También damos gracias por aquellos que compartieron su fe y nos inspiraron personalmente durante su vida en la tierra. Aquellos que nos han precedido y que, aunque no son conocidos por la Iglesia universal, están con Dios y, a través de su vida, nos siguen inspirando. **El Sábado 2 de Noviembre es el Día de Los Fieles Difuntos**, yo creo que es una continuación apropiada del día anterior, ya que recordamos a todos los que han muerto y oramos por ellos para que estén con Dios en el cielo.

Las misas para el Día de Los Fieles Difuntos serán a las 8:00 AM en inglés y a al mediodía en español.

Al igual que el año pasado, tendremos un Altar de Muertos. Les invitamos a traer fotos o recuerdos conmemorativos para este altar cuando venga a Misa. Puede dejarlos todo el mes de Noviembre si así lo desea. Incluya su nombre e información de contacto si desea sus fotos/recuerdos de regreso. También tendremos un libro para que escriban los nombres de sus fieles difuntos. Otra forma de orar por nuestros seres queridos es la Novena para los Fieles Difuntos. Tenemos sobres especiales para que escriba los nombres de sus seres queridos, puede incluir una donación en el sobre y luego colocarlo en la caja de caridad o en la canasta de la colecta. Recordaremos todo el mes de Noviembre a todos los que nos han precedido.

Este Lunes, Martes y Miércoles, el personal de la oficina, Padre Lucio, un miembro del Consejo Parroquial y yo, asistiremos a una conferencia sobre liderazgo parroquial. La conferencia se titula "Amazing Parish--Parroquia increíble". En la conferencia, expertos en organización de la Iglesia y liderazgo de empresas compartirán ideas y herramientas para ayudar a los líderes parroquiales a despertar a un sentido más profundo de la misión y para ayudar a encender a toda la parroquia en su papel en la misión para el Iglesia. 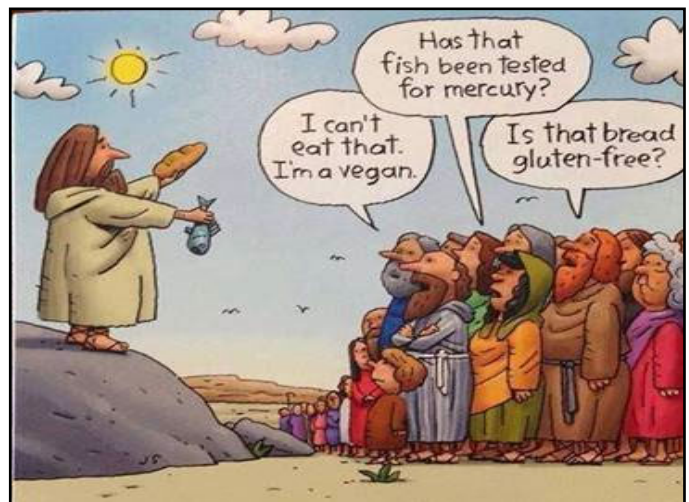
