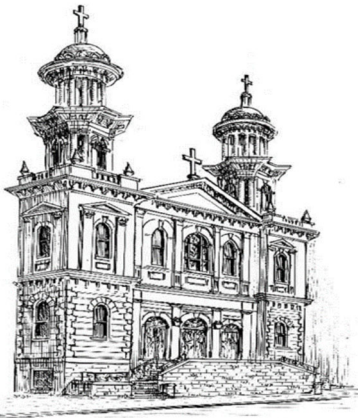

# FROM FATHER CHUCK'S DESK

**Happy Veteran's Day Weekend!** On Monday we honor all who have served in the military, especially those who have been put in harm's way during times of armed conflict. This day originally was known as Armistice Day, marking the first anniversary of the end of World War I. It is a day to pray for peace and for peace-making among nations and peoples. We give thanks for all those who are dedicating part or all of their career lifetimes to serving our country by keeping us all safe. We also give thanks for all retired military and lift up in prayer all veterans who have died. In a special way today I also call us to remember in prayer all our veterans who are homeless or wounded in body or spirit. We're called, as a nation and as a Church, to reach out to them and offer support & healing prayers. **We will offer a special Veteran's Day Mass at 9:00 AM, the only Mass on Monday, November 11.**

We discovered a glitch in the **myParish App** on the Mass schedule. If you downloaded it and find that the Mass schedule is incorrect, please delete the app & re-load it. When it comes back on it will have the correct schedule. Apparently, the computer system pulled from an old schedule & due to the construct of the cell phones it is put into memory and cannot be changed except by re-loading the app. It is a simple process that will only take you a few minutes. If you are on the app and discover other errors, please let us know. We are also working on getting our Sunday homilies on the app and our parish website. On the app there is a national link to homilies by others for the use of all parishes using myParish app. However, sometimes Father Lucio or I get requests from those at Mass to have a copy of our homilies for their reflection later in the week. If you are not yet on myParish App or if you need to reload it, just text the word APP to phone number 88202. You will get a reply with a link to download the app on your phone. In addition to special messages from the parish, the weekly bulletin & other parish information, the app will give you news stories, Mass times in churches when you're traveling, and the daily Scripture readings for Mass. If you have any questions about, this please let me know.

I would like to remind you to keep in prayer those journeying through the RCIA. We have about 16 adults and 5 children who are in the process of seeking the sacraments and coming into the Catholic Church. The 1<sup>st</sup> major rite, known as the Rite of Acceptance, will be celebrated on Sunday, November 24 at Mass. We pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in the hearts of those on this journey and for the sponsors in our parish needed to walk with them.

Mark your calendar. Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00 AM. This is one of my favorite liturgies of the year where we come together, accenting our various ethnic backgrounds, to celebrate thanks together as one family, one Church. If you speak the language of your heritage and would like to participate in our Prayers of the Faithful, I would love to have you be a part of the liturgy. I invite all in our community to come to the Mass in any ethnic or heritage dress you may have. We give thanks for the many gifts we receive and for the gift of one another, unity in our diversity, which enriches the whole community.

Next week the Women of St. Thomas Aquinas are hosting a health fair, be sure to plan a few extra minutes to come down to Righini Hall. As we move into winter, remember that, if you get sick you are not obligated to come to Mass. In fact, it is an act of care for others not to come to Mass when you are at risk of sharing your illness with others. Rather, you are encouraged to mark the sabbath Sunday by proper prayer and reflection at home. The Mass is available on TV on Channel 8 at 9:00 AM each Sunday, celebrated by our local area priests. It is presented so that those who are ill or incapacitated may attend Mass in this way. (It's your CSA dollars & other donations which support this outreach).

Este día fue originalmente conocido como el Día del Armisticio, marcando el primer aniversario del final de la Primera Guerra Mundial. Es un día para orar por la paz y por la edificación de la paz entre las naciones y los pueblos. Damos gracias por todos aquellos que están dedicando parte o la totalidad de su vida profesional a servir a nuestro país manteniéndonos a todos a salvo. También damos gracias por todos los militares retirados y oramos por los que han muerto. Les invito a recordar en oración a todos nuestros veteranos que están sin hogar o heridos en cuerpo o espíritu. Estamos llamados, como nación y como Iglesia, a tenderles la mano y ofrecerles apoyo y oraciones curativas. **Ofreceremos una Misa especial del Día para los Veteranos a las 9:00 AM, la única Misa el Lunes 11 de Noviembre.**

Descubrimos un fallo en la **aplicación de myParish** en el horario de las Misas. Si usted ya la descargó y descubre que el horario de las Misas es incorrecto, elimine la aplicación y vuelva a cargarla. Una vez reinstalada, tendrá el horario correcto. Aparentemente, la información se extrajo de un horario antiguo y no se puede cambiar excepto mediante la recarga de la aplicación. Es un proceso simple que sólo le llevará unos minutos. Si usted llega a descubrir otros errores en la aplicación, por favor háganoslo saber. También estamos trabajando en incluir nuestras homilias dominicales en la aplicación y nuestro sitio web. Actualmente en la aplicación, hay un enlace nacional a homilias para los usuarios de myParish. Sin embargo, en ocasiones el Padre Lucio o yo recibimos peticiones para obtener una copia de nuestras homilias para una reflexión más adelante en la semana. Si aún no está usando myParish App o necesita volver a cargarlo, simplemente envíe un mensaje de texto al: **88202** con la palabra: **APP**. Obtendrá una respuesta con un enlace para descargar la aplicación en su teléfono. Además de mensajes especiales de la parroquia, el boletín semanal y otra información parroquial, la aplicación le dará otros anuncios, horarios de Misa de otras iglesias para cuando usted esté viajando y las lecturas del día de las Misas. Si usted tiene alguna pregunta sobre la aplicación, por favor hágamelo saber.

Quiero recordarles que mantengan en oración a aquellos las personas que están preparándose por medio del programa de RCIA. Tenemos alrededor de 16 adultos y 5 niños que desean recibir sacramentos o ser recibidos en Comunión con la Iglesia Católica. El primer rito importante, conocido como el Rito de La Aceptación, se celebrará el Domingo 24 de Noviembre en la Misa. Pidamos que el Espíritu Santo guie a quienes se están preparando para recibir los sacramentos y a sus padrinos.

El Día de Acción de Gracias celebraremos una Misa a las 9:00 AM. Esta es una de mis liturgias favoritas del año en la que nos reunimos, acentuando nuestros diversos orígenes étnicos, para celebrar juntos como una sola familia, una sola Iglesia. Si hablan el idioma de su herencia y les gustaría participar en nuestras Oraciones de los Fieles, me encantaría que fueran parte de la liturgia. Invito a todos a venir a Misa con cualquier vestimenta étnica que puedan tener. Damos gracias por los muchos dones que recibimos y por el don de los demás, la unidad en nuestra diversidad, que enriquece a toda la comunidad.

El próximo fin de semana, las Mujeres de Sto. Tomás de Aquino patrocinarán una feria de salud, asegúrese de darse una vuelta por el Righini Hall. Recuerde que si se enferma no está obligado a venir a Misa. De hecho, es un acto de prudencia para los demás que no venga a Misa si su enfermedad es contagiosa. Más bien, se les anima a observar el domingo con reposo, oración y reflexión en casa. El Canal 8 televisa la Misa cada Domingo a las 9:00 AM, la cual es celebrada por nuestros sacerdotes de la diócesis.
