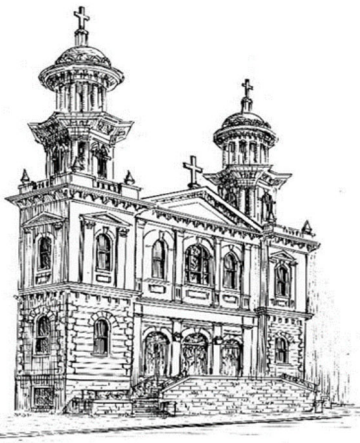

## FROM FATHER CHUCK'S DESK

**Happy Easter!** We can say that to one another for the next 40+ days, till Pentecost. The Church considers the 50 days of the Easter Season as one feast day, "*One Great Sunday*", as St. Athanasius put it. Today we conclude the most intense part of this celebration as it is the final day in the Octave of Easter. Each of these first eight days is a solemnity of the Church, the highest of feast days. Much more recently, since the year 2000, today also is called Divine Mercy Sunday, a day to recognize, yet again, the profound mercy and love demonstrated by our Lord. We hear it in today's Gospel as the risen Jesus appears to the frightened apostles in the upper room and breathes on them the Spirit of forgiveness. He returns a week later to offer mercy to Thomas who missed the first visit! We celebrate that the mercy of God knows no bounds.

God's merciful love is revealed in the sacraments, beginning with Baptism. On Easter Sunday we welcomed two new people into the Church: **Jason Wilson** was baptized and **Julie Nalley**, already baptized in the Baptist tradition, made her Catholic profession of faith. Both Jason and Julie joined **Christopher Clark, Andrea Gallegos, Sandra Lopez & Barbara Ojeda** in receiving Confirmation and Andrea, Sandra and Barbara also received their First Holy Communion. It was a wonderful celebration at the Easter Vigil. One final candidate from RCIA, **Mario Barragan**, will receive his Confirmation this Sunday at the 9:30 AM Mass. Congratulations and welcome!

The Easter Season is the opportune time to celebrate these sacraments of initiation. On Saturday morning we also celebrated the **First Reconciliation** for all our children preparing for their First Holy Communion to be received next month. Also, at the end of next month our teens preparing for Confirmation will receive that sacrament. Please remember to keep all our young parishioners in your prayers as they journey through these final weeks of preparation.

**As promised, we will be offering registration for "online" giving.** This will be a big help to the parish and to all of our parishioners (including yours truly) by having a convenient and consistent method of financial support to the parish. Your regular giving helps us pay priests, staff and the monthly expenses of running the parish. There is no other source of income for these expenses, so your support is vital. Thanks to ALL of you who give so that we can keep our doors open and services strong. On-line giving assures that our donations continue even if we are away (or forget to bring it with us to Mass!). More details will be coming. If you come to a morning Mass, please plan to come down to Righini Hall for coffee and a donut next weekend to learn more and, hopefully, sign up!

All Operation Rice Bowls are due back now. I always find this to be an important part of my Lenten journey, praying with and learning about some of the inspiring folks helped by Catholic Relief Services. You may place your cardboard rice bowl in the basket in front of the altar or bring them to the office or, if you prefer, write a check for whatever amount you contributed and deliver or send to the office. We will send one check on to the diocese which, in turn, sends one check in the name of all participating parishes to CRS. Thanks very much to all who participated!

## DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PADRE CHUCK

¡Feliz Pascua! Podemos decir esta frase el uno al otro durante los próximos 40 días, hasta Pentecostés. La Iglesia ha considerado los 50 días de la época de Pascua como un día festivo, "Un Gran Domingo" como dijo San Atanasio. Hoy concluimos la parte más intensa de esta celebración ya que es el último día en la octava de Pascua. Cada uno de estos primeros ocho días es una solemnidad de la Iglesia, el más alto de los días de fiesta. Mucho más recientemente, desde el año 2000, hoy también se llama Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, un día para reconocer, una vez más, la profunda misericordia y el amor demostrados por nuestro Señor. Lo escuchamos en el Evangelio de hoy cuando Jesús resucitado aparece a los apóstoles asustados en el aposento alto y les sopla el Espíritu del perdón. ¡Jesús Regresa una semana más tarde para ofrecer misericordia a Tomas, quien no estaba presente en su primera visita! Celebramos que la misericordia de Dios no conoce límites.

El amor misericordioso de Dios se revela en los sacramentos, comenzando con el bautismo. El domingo de Pascua acogimos a dos personas nuevas en la Iglesia: Jason Wilson fue bautizado y Julie Nalley, ya bautizada en la tradición Bautista, hizo su profesión a la fe católica. Tanto Jason como Julie se unieron a Christopher Clark, Andrea Gallegos, Sandra López y Barbara Ojeda en recibir la Confirmación y Andrea, Sandra y Barbara también recibieron su Primera Comunión. La Vigilia Pascual fue una celebración maravillosa. Un candidato final del programa de RCIA, Mario Barragan, recibirá su confirmación este Domingo en la Misa de las 9:30 AM. ¡Felicidades y Bienvenidos!

La época de Pascua es el momento oportuno para celebrar estos sacramentos de iniciación. El Sábado por la mañana celebramos la Primera Reconciliación para los niños que se preparan para recibir su Primera Santa Comunión el próximo mes. También al final del próximo mes, nuestros adolescentes que se preparan para el Sacramento de la confirmación recibirán ese Sacramento. Por favor, recuerden mantener a todos nuestros jóvenes feligreses en sus oraciones mientras atraviesan estas últimas semanas de preparación.
