FROM FATHER CHUCK'S DESK

In addition to being the Sixth Sunday of Easter, it is Memorial Day weekend. We extend a special welcome to all our visitors on this three-day weekend. We also remember all those who have lost their lives to war while serving their country in the military. Memorial Day began as Decoration Day back in 1868, a day to decorate the graves of those who died during war, the deadliest time of war for this country, our Civil War. As time and, sadly, wars, continued, this day was expanded to include all who lost their lives in wartime. The danger of a public holiday like this is that people forget the purpose for the Monday off & it just becomes another "three-day weekend". So we pause to lift our beloved dead in prayer, to honor them and to pray for true and lasting peace, the best tribute we could give to those who gave their lives.

I want to highlight and remind everyone of our on-line giving which is now available. Go to our website: www.stacathedral.com and click on the "on-line giving" tab. It will guide you from there. We have ten or twelve households signed up thus far, so please do check it out. You do not have to be registered to give in this way, so I extend this invitation to our visitors also, especially those who are with us several times a year. Visitors' support is crucial for a downtown parish like St. Thomas. Thanks to everyone for your consistent generosity!

It was announced at the retreat that Fr. Tom Fransiscus will be retiring due to health reasons. Not that he is entitled at the age of 80+ years! Fr. Tom, a Redemptorist priest, has faithfully served the Diocese of Reno for over 25 years in various parishes, including as pastor at St. Michael's in Stead and St. Ann's in Dayton, as well as our Judicial Vicar, head of the Tribunal of the Diocese for many years. Fr. Tom will be moving to the Redemptorist Assisted Care Facility in St. Louis. He has been a friend as well as brother priest and he will be missed around here. Please keep him in your prayers as he continues to recover from surgeries and convalesce.

It is a bit hard for me to believe, but 25 years ago, May 22, 1994—A Pentecost Sunday, I celebrated my first Mass here at the Cathedral, my home parish. I'm extremely grateful for my priesthood and the many years of ministry I have experienced in many places. In thanksgiving, I am hosting a first-time Pentecost Concert here at the Cathedral and am inviting musicians and singers from the various communities where I have served. The concert will take place on Saturday, June 8th, at 7:00 PM and all are invited. I am hoping that this will be the beginning of an annual Cathedral event highlighting the gift of our musicians in the parishes of the diocese. Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, is an ideal time for us to gather in such celebration. There will be a simple reception in Righini Hall following the concert. I hope you can come. (This is a free and no-gift event. However, if anyone would like to bring some healthy, non-perishable item for the St. Francis of Assisi Pantry, that would be great.)

Por favor, manténganlo en sus oraciones mientras continúa en reposo recuperándose de sus cirugías.

Es un poco difícil de creer, pero hace 25 años, el 22 de Mayo de 1994--un Domingo de Pentecostés, celebré mi primer Misa aquí en la Catedral, mi parroquia natal. Estoy sumamente agradecido por mi sacerdocio y por los muchos años de Ministerio que he experimentado en muchos lugares. En Acción de Gracias, estoy organizando por primera vez aquí en la Catedral, un concierto de Pentecostés y estoy invitando a músicos y cantantes de las diversas comunidades donde he servido. Se llevará a cabo el Sábado 8 de Junio a las 7:00 PM y todos están invitados. Espero que este sea el comienzo de un evento anual de la Catedral que destaque el don de nuestros músicos en las parroquias de la Diócesis. Pentecostés, el cumpleaños de la Iglesia, es un momento ideal para que nos reunamos en tal celebración. Habrá una sencilla recepción en Righini Hall después del concierto. Espero que puedan venir. (Este es un evento gratuito y les pido no traigan regalos. Sin embargo, si alguien quiere traer un poco de comida en lata para el dispensario de comida St. Francis de Asís, sería genial.)
