We are in the throes of Artown now with lots of wonderful & interesting music, dance, theater and other arts to experience and enjoy. It also calls us to a bit more patience around town as we maneuver through or around certain events, especially around the Cathedral with the river and park just across the street. Remember that Arlington Avenue and some other streets around us may be closed on the weekends. You can check out the website: www.reno.gov/government/departments/public-works/traffic-engineering/road-closures to see if any such closures are happening around us. Artown.org will give you an idea of some events you may want to attend.

I applaud those who are on vacation or otherwise traveling who make a point of getting to Mass wherever they are. I know sometimes it is an effort to find churches and times, but it is important to keep holy the Sabbath by participating in the Mass. That obligation is not lifted merely because it is inconvenient. We ought not attend Mass out of obligation, but out of thanksgiving, an opportunity to come together as a diverse people to praise God, hear God's Word, receive the Body and Blood of Christ and be strengthened to live out the gospel in the week ahead. Paul's letter in the 2nd reading prays, "May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord, Jesus Christ." Each time we gather for the Mass we remember and share the story of the cross, the Paschal Mystery: Jesus' passion, death and resurrection. It is integral that we do not put other things or events above the celebration of the Mass together, as the Second Vatican Council put it, the "Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life." (Lumen Gentium #11) As such, we want to do our very best to celebrate the Mass weekly, with joy and thanksgiving.

I also enjoy seeing and experiencing how other parish communities come together and celebrate Mass. It is nice to share good ideas and practices with one another. Let us always be mindful of this great gift we share with one another and with our loving God.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PADRE CHUCK

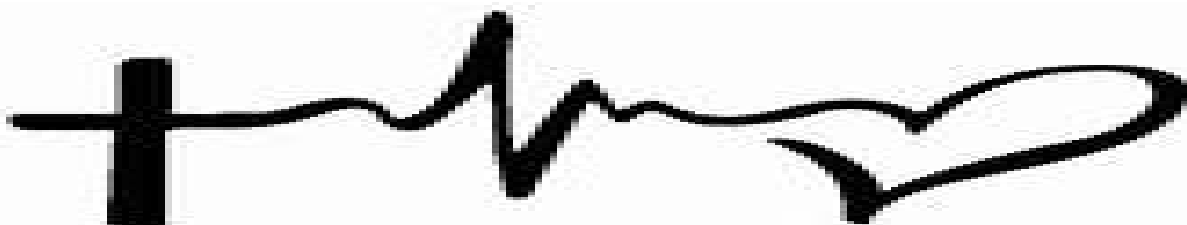

Esta obligación no se levanta por el simple hecho de ser inconveniente. No debemos asistir a Misa por obligación, sino en acción de gracias, una oportunidad de reunirnos como un pueblo diverso para alabar a Dios, escuchar la Palabra de Dios, recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo y ser fortalecidos para vivir el Evangelio en la semana venidera. La carta de san Pablo en la segunda lectura dice: "Que nunca me vocifere, excepto en la cruz de nuestro Señor Jesucristo." Cada vez que nos reunimos para la Misa recordamos y compartimos la historia de la cruz, el Misterio pascual: la pasión, la muerte y la resurrección de Jesús. Es vital que no pongamos otras cosas o acontecimientos por encima de la celebración de la Misa, como dijo el Concilio Vaticano II, la "Eucaristía es la fuente y la cumbre de la vida cristiana". (Lumen Gentium #11) Como tal, debemos hacer todo lo posible para celebrar la Misa cada semana con alegría y en acción de gracias.

También disfruto ver y experimentar cómo otras comunidades parroquiales se unen y celebran la Misa. Es agradable compartir buenas ideas y prácticas entre sí. Seamos siempre conscientes de este gran don que compartimos unos con otros y con nuestro Dios amoroso.

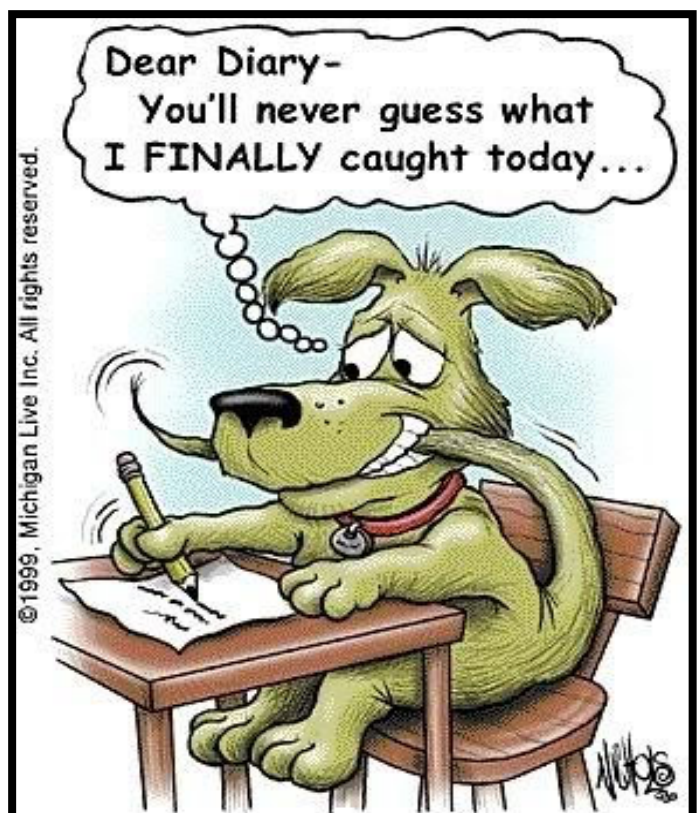
