You may have seen that Governor Sisolak has extended the closing of schools and on-line learning through the end of the year. Our religious education program for our children will do the same. Thanks to our staff and teachers, religious teaching has continued for our parish on-line. We want our young people to continue to be formed in the faith, and, for those preparing for sacraments, that they will be ready to receive once we are able to return to church.

In keeping with the guidance of civil authorities, Bishop Calvo will be issuing a phase-in approach for how we might return to mass and other parish activities. That won't happen until we have reached a decline of COVID 19 cases in our community for 14 days. Once that happens, we will likely begin to phase in mass attendance, with appropriate social distancing and safeguards. After the sacrificing all have made, we don't want to jump back too soon and re-ignite the spreading of the virus. Please stay tuned for details on when and how the phasing will take place.
