**THE TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

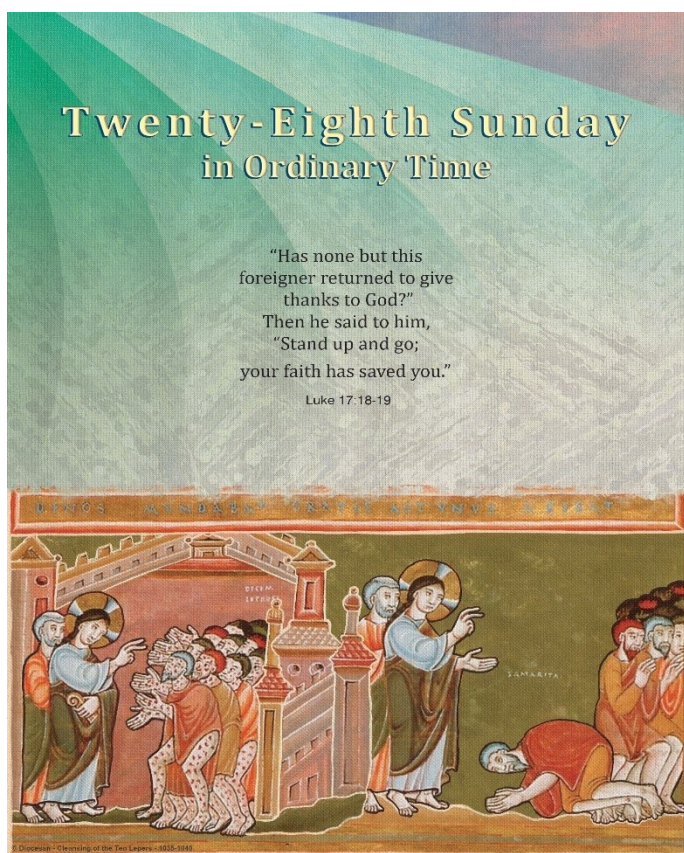
**First Reading** — I pleaded, and the spirit of wisdom came to me. All good things together came to me in her company (Wisdom 7:7-11).

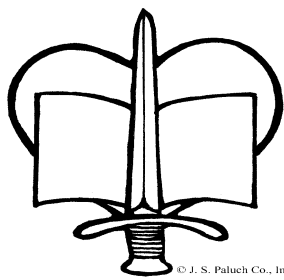

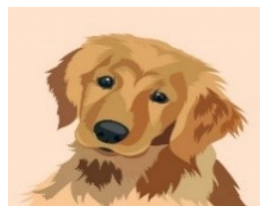


### **CHRISTMAS CASH/EARLY**

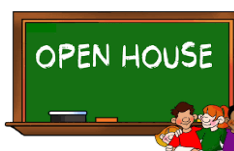
