MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

I fly out to Barcelona, Spain with the group on pilgrimage to the Marian shrines in Montserrat, Spain; Lourdes, France and Fatima, Portugal. I will be gone for three weeks, with days of vacation in Southern France (staying with the Oblates of Mary Immaculate in Aix-en-Provence, the hometown of their founder, Saint Eugène de Mazenod) and then a retreat with the ecumenical monastic order of men in the village of Taizé, (Burgundy) France. I'll return to the Parishes on October 4th, so I'll miss the SH Turkey Dinner. Father Frank Lenz, one of our retired priests who has covered for me here at least a couple of times before, will preside at Sunday Eucharist September 16/17 & 23/24, and Father Tony Pesek, a retired priest of the Archdiocese of San Antonio now living in Shiner, will preside on September 30/October 1. Keep me in your prayers, as I will keep you all in mine.

Yo vuelo a Barcelona, España con el grupo en peregrinación a los santuarios marianos en Montserrat, España; Lourdes, Francia y Fátima, Portugal. Me ausentaré durante tres semanas, con días de vacaciones en el sur de Francia (voy a quedarme con los Oblatos de María Inmaculada en Aix-en-Provence, la ciudad natal de su fundador, San Eugène de Mazenod) y luego un retiro con la orden monástica ecuménica de los hombres en el pueblo de Taizé, (Borgoña) Francia. Regresaré a las parroquias el 4 de octubre, así que me perderé la Cena de Turquía. El Padre Frank Lenz, uno de nuestros sacerdotes jubilados que me ha cubierto aquí por lo menos un par de veces, presidirá la Eucaristía dominical los días 16/17 y 23/24 de septiembre, y el Padre Tony Pesek, un sacerdote retirado de la Arquidiócesis de San Antonio que ahora vive en Shiner, presidirá el 30 de septiembre / 1 de octubre. Manténme en sus oraciones, ya que voy a mantener a todos ustedes en la mía.
