## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Join me in praising God: At the 5:00 Sunday Eucharist last Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup> we baptized **Alexia Yvonne Manzano**, daughter of **Rocio** and **Herman**. May God's grace help us to remain faithful to the Spirit we have received through the sacraments.

I encourage you to pray a novena to the Holy Spirit during the nine days before the Solemnity of Pentecost, this year May 31<sup>th</sup> –June 8<sup>th</sup>. Here is the same simple prayer schedule for the novena that I gave you last year: Day 1 (Friday): Read chapter 1 of the Acts of the Apostles; Day 2-8: read one of the seven sections of Psalm 104 with the antiphon (verse 30) before and after the section - **Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.**; Day 9 (Saturday): Read chapter 2 of the Acts of the Apostles.
