MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

In order to pastorally care for those who have physical and emotional concerns regarding COVID-19, **Bishop Brendan Cahill** has extended the dispensation from the obligation for Catholics to attend Sunday Mass in person until July 31, 2020. Also, there are now at least three parishes in the Diocese who have had to implement stronger restrictions or have had more difficulties in scheduling and sanitizing because of cases of the corona virus. If you are or have been sick or have been in contact with anyone who has been sick, **please stay at home**.

On another topic: It is common for us Catholics to encourage those who worship at least part-time in a particular parish and participate in that parish's formation sessions and other activities, to register with that parish. Being registered with a parish allows for better communication with parishioners and helps designate who is to receive the benefits of being a "registered parishioner." One such benefit is the price difference for a "parishioner / non-parishioner" in the purchase of a grave space in our cemeteries. I am instituting a new designation for Sacred Heart Parish, Flatonia (the Parish) and Saints Cyril and Methodius Parish, Cistern (the Parish):

Registered parishioner families are those who are at least part-time residents of the Flatonia / Cistern area, are participating in Sunday Mass at the Parish, and are contributing at least \$100 / year to the Parish and \$100 / year to the Diocesan Services Appeal (DSA) through the Parish.

Please read the full Cemetery Policy included in this bulletin and discuss it as a family. There are additional copies of the policies for both parish cemeteries at the main entrances of the churches. Let us hold each other in spiritual communion.

*Para cuidar pastoralmente a aquellos que tienen preocupaciones físicas y emocionales con respecto a COVID-19, el **Obispo Brendan Cahill** ha extendido la dispensa de la obligación de los católicos de asistir a la misa dominical en persona hasta el 31 de julio de 2020. Además, ahora hay al menos tres parroquias en la Diócesis que han tenido que implementar restricciones más estrictas o han tenido más dificultades para programar y desinfectar debido a los casos del corona virus. Si está o ha estado enfermo o ha estado en contacto con alguien que ha estado enfermo, **quédese en casa**.*

Sobre otro tema: Es común para nosotros los católicos alentar a los que adoran al menos a tiempo parcial en una parroquia en particular y participan en las sesiones de formación y otras actividades de esa parroquia, que se registren en esa parroquia. Estar registrado en una parroquia permite una mejor comunicación con los parroquianos y ayuda a designar quién recibirá los beneficios de ser un "parroquiano registrado". Uno de esos beneficios es la diferencia de precio para un "parroquiano / no parroquiano" en la compra de un espacio de entierro en nuestros cementerios. Estoy instituyendo una nueva designación para la Parroquia del Sacred Heart, Flatonia (la Parroquia) y la Parroquia de Saints Cyril & Methodius, Cistern (la Parroquia):

Las familias registradas de parroquianos son aquellas que son al menos residentes de tiempo parcial del área de Flatonia / Cistern, participan en la misa dominical en la Parroquia, y contribuyen al menos \$ 100 / año a la Parroquia y \$ 100 / año a la Apelación de Servicios Diocesanos (DSA) a través de la Parroquia.
