## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

So, Ash Wednesday is right around the corner: February 17<sup>th</sup>. As I encouraged each family to review the Mass schedule before Christmas Eve / Day, I do so again for Ash Wednesday. You'll find the listing for Masses and Services under the FUTURE EVENTS section of this bulletin. Please decide early as to which service is best to attend. I especially encourage all those who can to participate before 5:30 PM. Please don't leave the decision to the afternoon of Ash Wednesday.

I continue to praise God for both: those who have been attending while practicing the required precautions and those who have decided not to attend Mass to remain safe during this COVID-19 pandemic. On that note, if you haven't been attending, I don't think Ash Wednesday is the time to return; let's continue what we've been doing until the coast is clear. I would hate to turn anyone away, but we cannot have overcrowding in the churches. I know that receiving ashes is an important tradition for us, but there is no guilt playing it safe this year by praying as a family at home. A special At Home Liturgy of the Word worship aid will be provided on our website and at the churches' main entrances for just that. As in the past, ashes will be left out during Lent; this year, hand sanitizer is to be used before and after using the ashes. Yo sé que recibir cenizas es una tradición importante para nosotros, pero no hay culpa de ir a lo seguro este año al orar en familia en casa. Se proporcionará una ayuda especial para la adoración de La Liturgia de la Palabra en el Hogar en nuestro sitio web y en las entradas principales de las iglesias solo para eso. Como en el pasado, las cenizas se dejarán fuera durante la Cuaresma; este año, se debe usar desinfectante para manos antes y después de usar las cenizas.
