MESSAGE FROM THE DEACON

"...Would that all the people of the LORD were prophets!..." Great words from Moses in today's first reading. How great it would be indeed if we were first and foremost prophets. How great if we all would prioritize spreading the gospel! So, what stands in our way? This is the message for this week's readings.

In the time of Jesus, hierarchy and stature were very important aspects of the culture. Group identity was critical, and the privileges associated with being a part of a particular group were guarded and prized. So, when someone outside of the disciples began to drive out demons, the disciple John was instinctively jealous and protective of the status of being a disciple of Jesus. But Jesus cautions him. What does it matter if this person does not belong to the group? He is doing good work!

Jesus also takes the moment to further teach them the importance of always sticking to the mission. Everything they did influenced those they are ministering to. What they did had just as much of an impact as what they said and taught. Plain and simple, he is telling them do not cling to silly prerogatives and privileges. Do not let jealousy and rivalries take precedence over the mission. Cling to the mission of bringing the good news message to the world and being a conduit of grace.
