MASS INTENTIONS (\$10.00)

The Church considers the Mass the greatest possible prayer of intercession because it is the perfect offering of Christ to the Father by making present the Paschal Mystery of His death and resurrection.

It is a longstanding tradition in the Church that a Priest may be requested to offer a Mass for a specific intention, even when one cannot be physically present at the Mass.

The faithful make a free will offering, called a stipend, to a priest or Religious Community in order to apply the Mass to a specific intention. By making this offering, the faithful, by making their own offering, associate themselves more intimately with Christ who offers Himself in the Sacred Host, and thereby obtain more abundant fruits (refer to Pope Paul VI's letter "Firma in Traditione" (Firm in Tradition) of June 13, 1974).

From July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 the weekly need is \$3,977.00. This does not include Religious Education, Youth Ministry personnel, which could account for \$16,000 or more, nor does it include the Capital Campaign. However, we are able to keep up financially because of your added contributions to the Fall Festival, Chili Feed and Christmas Bazaar fundraisers. Thank you to all who contribute.

Divine Worship

Dear Parishioners,

The Archbishop has published an Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook for all the faithful of the Archdiocese. Chapter 1A Section 1.1.1 states: *“The Most Holy Eucharist, ‘stands at the center of the Church’s life’,¹ since it truly ‘contains the Church’s entire spiritual wealth: Christ himself, our Passover and Living Bread.’² ‘The Church has received the Eucharist from Christ her Lord not as one gift— however precious—along so many others, but as the gift par excellence, for it is the gift of himself, of his person in his sacred humanity, as well as the gift of his saving work.’³ That surpassing gift of the Eucharist is where the Church draws her life, the dynamic force of all her activity and her whole sense of purpose and direction. As the Second Vatican Council proclaimed, the Eucharistic sacrifice is ‘the source and summit of Christian life.’⁴”*

There is a copy in our office and everyone is invited to come and learn what is in the handbook. The book will remain in the office.

May god bless all of us as we continue to practice our faith under this Liturgical Guidance.
