## Divine Worship

Continuing from Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook (ALH) Chapter 1J states:

### J. CELEBRATION OF THE HOLY MASS

#### *Liturgy of the Word*

Section 1.51.1: In the celebration of the Mass with a congregation, the readings are always proclaimed from the ambo. The psalmist, or the cantor of the Psalm, sings the verses of the Psalm from the ambo or another suitable place.<sup>187</sup>

Section 1.51.2: It is illicit to omit or to substitute the prescribed biblical readings on one's own initiative, and it is forbidden "to substitute other, non-biblical texts for the readings and responsorial Psalm, which contain the Word of God." The practice by which priests, deacons or the faithful alter or vary at will the texts of the Sacred Liturgy that they are charged to pronounce is not acceptable, for in doing thus, they render the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy unstable, and not infrequently distort the authentic meaning of the liturgy. These texts include the Mass parts that are sung or spoken, such as the Gloria, the Creed, and others.<sup>188</sup>

Section 1.51.3 In the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon, it is customary that, after the Gospel reading, the deacon takes the book to a bishop celebrant, who kisses it, saying inaudibly, "May the words of the Gospel wipe away our sins." Alternatively, if the celebrant is not a bishop, the deacon or priest who reads the Gospel himself kisses the book and inaudibly says the same words.<sup>189</sup>

Section 1.51.4 On solemn occasions, as he judges appropriate, a bishop may impart to the people a blessing with the Book of the Gospels after having kissed it.<sup>190</sup>
