## Divine Worship

Continuing from Archdiocesan Liturgical Handbook (ALH) Chapter 1J states:

Section 1.55.8: The bread and wine are deposited on the altar by the priest to the accompaniment of the prescribed formulas.<sup>211</sup> Since the Precious Blood cannot be reserved,<sup>212</sup> only that amount of wine should be consecrated which will be consumed by the faithful.

Section 1.55.9: The priest may incense the gifts placed upon the altar. If incense is used, the priest then puts some in the thurible, blesses it without saying anything, and incenses the gifts, the cross, and the altar, so as to signify the Church's offering and prayer rising like incense in the sight of God. The deacon assists the priest during the incensation of the gifts, the cross, and the altar; afterwards, the deacon himself, the acolyte, or another minister incenses the priest and the people.<sup>213</sup>

Section 1.55.10 The priest then washes his hands at the side of the altar, a rite that is an expression of his desire for interior purification.<sup>214</sup>

### *Eucharistic Prayer*

Section 1.56.1 The Eucharistic Prayer "by its very nature is the climax of the whole celebration".<sup>215</sup> The priest prays it aloud, reciting or singing it according to the rubrics and during this time "there should be no other prayers or singing, and the organ or other musical instruments should be silent".<sup>216</sup> except for the people's acclamations that have been duly approved.<sup>217</sup>

Section 1.56.2 Only those Eucharistic Prayers are to be used which are found in the Roman Missal or are legitimately approved by the Apostolic See, and according to the manner and the terms set forth by it. "It is not to be tolerated that some priests take upon themselves the right to compose their own Eucharistic Prayers" or to change the same texts approved by the Church, or to introduce others composed by private individuals.<sup>218</sup>
