*The family is where the child will learn about God. The Church is the second teacher of the faith; we are here to “assist” the parents in continuing to teach.*  
(National Catechetical Directory, para. 212)

### THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

- I. I am the Lord, your God, you shall not have strange gods before Me.
- II. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- III. Remember to keep holy the Lord’s Day.
- IV. Honor your Father and your Mother.
- V. You shall not kill.
- VI. You shall not commit adultery.
- VII. You shall not steal.
- VIII. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- IX. You shall not covet your neighbor’s wife.
- X. You shall not covet your neighbor’s goods.

### WHAT IS THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE?

For those sins committed after Baptism, a person is reconciled with God and with the Church through the Sacrament of Penance.  
(CCC, 984-985)

### WHAT IS SIN?

Sin is any thought, word, desire, or action that destroys or damages our union with God.

### HOW MANY KINDS OF SIN ARE THERE?

There are two kinds of personal sin (actual sin that we ourselves freely commit) – mortal and venial.

### WHAT IS VENIAL SIN?

Personal sin that weakens but does not kill our relationship with God.

### WHAT IS MORTAL SIN?

Mortal sin is a serious violation of God’s law. Personal sin that totally rejects God and alienates one from Him, causing a loss of love and sanctifying grace.

### WHY GO TO CONFESSION?

#### THE GOSPEL OF SAINT JOHN 20:23 STATES:

<sup>23</sup>“Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.”

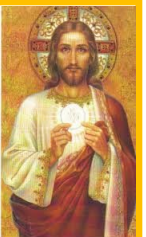

### THE EUCHARIST

The Mass is a true sacrifice. The sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross is offered in the Holy Eucharist in an unbloody and sacramental way. It is a memorial (past, present and future).

### WHAT IS THE HOLY EUCHARIST?

The Holy Eucharist is the Sacrament in which Jesus Christ is really and physically present in **body, blood, soul and divinity**, under the appearances of bread & wine.

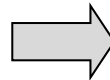

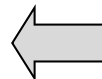
