

PRAYERS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Children must know the following basic prayers BEFORE entering the Sacramental Preparation Classes for Reconciliation (Penance) and First Holy Communion:

Sign of the Cross

In the Name of the Father,
and of the Son,
and the Holy Spirit, Amen.



With your right hand:

To your forehead say:

In the Name of the Father,

*To your abdomen say: **and of the Son,***

From left shoulder to right shoulder say:

and the Holy Spirit, Put hands together in prayer and say: Amen.

The Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

*A **bow of the head** is made when the three Divine Persons are named together (as in the Glory Be), as a sign of reverence and honor.*



The Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

The Our Father

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; Thy Kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day, our daily bread; And Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

FOR THE PARENT:

The family is where the child will learn about God. The Church is the second teacher of the faith; we are here to “assist” the parents in continuing to teach.

All children who will be entering classes for Sacramental Preparation **should already know** the basic prayers in this pamphlet.

It is important for you to **pray at home** with your children. Daily repetition is the best way for them to memorize prayer.

THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION

The faithful are obliged to participate in the Sunday Eucharist and on Holy Days of Obligation. Those who fail in this obligation commit a grave sin (CCC 2181)



Parents who do not bring their children to Mass on Sunday commit grave sin. Grave sin destroys our Communion with God and condemns us to eternal punishment.

PLEASE NOTE: From Bishop Flores: All the faithful are dispensed from the obligation to assist at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days until further notice.

We should do our best to participate in Masses that are offered On-Line or Live Streamed. Let us seek to incorporate the Rosary, and meditation on the daily readings. It is important to learn how to make a spiritual communion.

Please Note: No pass evaluations or no parent participation may mean the Sacrament Preparation classes will be postponed until child is ready. The child will be assigned to a regular CCE class until the following year.


