



NJ Tax Amnesty 2018

Under a new law signed in July, the NJ Division of Taxation has been authorized to implement a tax amnesty program, providing taxpayers with the opportunity to file past tax returns and/or pay back taxes along with only half of the interest due as of November 1, 2018. The 2018 New Jersey Tax Amnesty began November 15, 2018 and ends January 15, 2019. Amnesty will only apply to outstanding tax filings or payments that are reportable on a tax return due on or after February 1, 2009, and prior to September 1, 2017.
