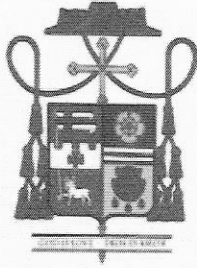

Dear Friends in Christ,

*Each of us can discover in Joseph - the man who goes unnoticed,  
a daily, discreet and hidden presence - an intercessor, a support  
and a guide in times of trouble.*

Pope Francis, *Patris Corde*

With his announcement of a Year of St. Joseph, Pope Francis has invited us to commemorate the 150th anniversary of Blessed Pius IX's proclamation of St. Joseph as the Patron of the Catholic Church. He offers us this year, in our parishes, our Diocese of Paterson and the universal Church, to draw closer to the one who loved Jesus "with a father's heart."

While we plan to observe this year solemnly and enthusiastically, I offer some preliminary resources and suggestions to assist you in your own celebration of the Year of St. Joseph in your parish.

1. **Read** and encourage others to read **Pope Francis' beautiful reflection on St. Joseph in his Apostolic Letter *Patris Corde***. 2. **Be aware** of the Apostolic Penitentiary's Decree concerning **the special graces that may be obtained during this year**. This may be a good opportunity to communicate carefully the Church's renewed understanding of the communion of saints and the granting of indulgences. These will help:



When that is complete, I will share that plan with you so that we all may ask St. Joseph to show himself a father to us as he was to Jesus, and guide us in the path of life.
