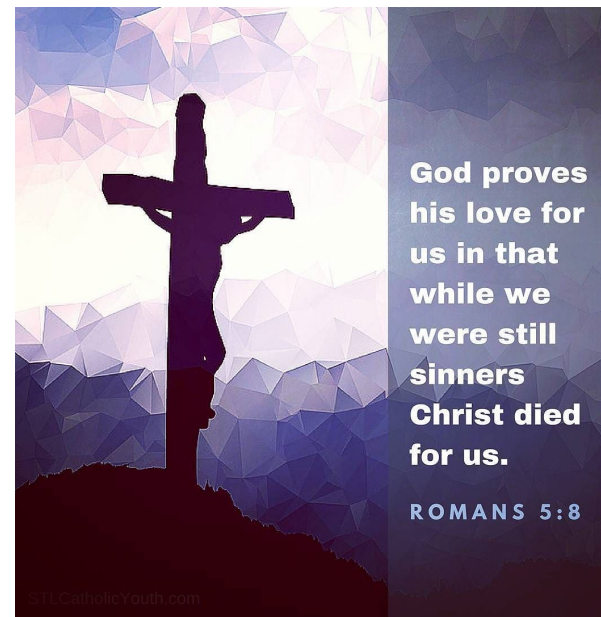
Is an acronym for:
