Masses Resume

The faithful remain dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation.

- Mass Times: Mon-Fri 8AM & 12:10PM, Sat 5PM, Sun 7:30AM, 9:30AM, 11:15AM, 1:15PM, 5:30PM
- 250 Attendee Max in church sanctuary
- 100 Attendee Max in St. Mary's Hall with streamed service
- 5PM Saturday Mass will be streamed live on Facebook and sppnb.org

Attendees Must:

All those who enter the Church property must:

- Wear a mask
- Remain 6 feet apart
- Wash or sanitize hands
- Follow posted signage
- Listen to staff and usher instructions

During Mass No...

- Physical sign of peace
- Chalice distribution
- Worship aids or song books
- Passing of collection baskets (placed near exits)
- Congregating before or after Mass

The Church will be disinfected after each Liturgy.

Communion

- Eucharistic Ministers will wear masks
- Blessed Sacrament may only be received by hand
- Masks must be worn until the faithful step away from the minister and can pull their mask down to consume the host

*Homebound may request Communion

Other Sacraments

- Follow the above guidelines when applicable
- Confessions will be held at the normal times, following social distancing

Stay Home If...

- You have *preexisting conditions* or are *immunocompromised*
- You are *feeling sick*
- You *suspect you may be sick* or have been *exposed to COVID-19*
- You have a *sick family member at home*
- You are *over the age of 60* or their *caretaker*
