

# **Sts Mary and Edward Safety Guidelines during COVID-19**

Important information that we need to know regarding the latest on COVID-19

- The virus spreads most commonly from person-to-person close contact (within six feet).
- It is spread through respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs or sneezes.
- It may also be possible that COVID-19 can spread from contact with infected surfaces or objects (although this is not believed to be the main way the virus spreads).

For your safety, the safety of your family, and all who attend and serve during the Mass (our Pastor, Altar Servers, Ushers, etc.), we ask you to follow the guidelines that Sts. Mary and Edward have prepared.

It is mandatory to wear a mask or face covering while you are in the Church or Price Building and during mass.

Social distancing - Stay at 6 feet apart

Single entry/exit - Please use single entry when exiting Church

Holy Eucharist - The distribution of Holy Communion is only to be by means of one species, the Sacred Body. And it will be received only on the hand.

Hymnals - No Missals, hymnals or programs will be used

Ushers will guide you before, during and after the Liturgy.

# Online Registration to attend Mass on Sundays during COVID 19

1. In the Home Page of the Website there is an icon: SIGN UP GENIUS
2. Click on there
3. Click on Sign Up Sheet for Masses
4. You will see 10am Mass – English and 12pm Mass – Spanish
5. Mark on sign up
6. At the bottom of the same page click on Submit sign up
7. Fill your complete name and number of adults and number of children, email address and phone #
8. Click on Sign up now when you are done
9. You will receive confirmation of your registration
10. Total Number of attendees will be 35
11. Please arrive 15 minutes earlier. An usher will be at the door with the list of parishioners that are registered to attend mass. Walk-ins will not be allowed, make sure you are registered. Doors will be closed as soon as Mass starts. If you cannot attend Mass please cancel your registration so that other parishioner can use it.
12. If you have any symptoms of cold or cough or have been close to a person that have been sick, please stay at home. It is mandatory to wear a mask. Children 4 years and older must wear a mask.
13. Please bear with the ushers, they are only trying to keep us safe.
