

## Social Studies/Science Lesson Plans—week of March 23-27, 2020

### Topic: Seasons, Spring & Women's History

TEKS: SS(B)13a; 14a-d & LA: K.5-K.6, SC.2.D, SC.5.A, SC.8.A

#### Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>:

Materials Needed: Ipad or computer, pencil, crayons, chalk & paper

-visit the website <https://classroommagazines.scholastic.com/support/learnathome/grades-prek-k.html>

-Go to Day 5 Seasons - Spring.

-listen to and read the stories. Children can complete the online activities

-Weather permitting, go outside, have student draw their favorite season on driveway or sidewalk.

#### Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup>:

Materials Needed: Social Studies Book (My World), pencil, crayons & paper.

-Read page 136 on Sally Ride. Continue learning about Sally Ride.

-On Epic; Read "Cupcakes with Sally Ride" by Kayla Stein Kraus.

-Ask students what other women leaders they might know from school, TV, family, etc.

-Draw & color a space person & rocket using shapes **as seen on Ready Set Draw! on Epic=How to Draw using shapes by Tim Miller.**

#### Wednesday, March 25<sup>th</sup>:

Materials needed: Ipad or computer, pencil and Brainpop Activity sheet.

-watch the video about Spring at <https://jr.brainpop.com/science/weather/spring/>

-print the "activity" sheet, take a walk outside and record observations

**Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup>:**

Materials Needed: Discovery Education App, pencil, crayons & paper.

-View video on Amelia Earhart, Time Warp Trio: "The High & the Fighty".

**Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>:**

Materials Needed: Social Studies Book, pencil & paper.

-Read with student pages 150-153 in Social Studies Book.

-Complete areas as needed.

-Ask the following questions:

Why do you think Clara Barton wrote letters to soldiers' families?

Why was Clara Barton important?

Why do people volunteer? Perhaps tell student how you volunteer....
