Dear Families,

We are currently planning our First Reconciliation retreat for the children of our parish and school – we are looking forward to offering our children this additional sacramental preparation during what we hope will be a fun and enriching morning for them! A retreat is an experience where our children can come together in a relaxed setting to learn more about the Sacrament of Reconciliation through activities, stories, and art. It offers an experience supplemental to what they are learning at home and in the classroom as they prepare for First Reconciliation.

Our retreat will run on Saturday, November 16th from 9:30 am – 11:00 am. (All First Communicants are expected to attend as part of their sacramental preparation.) Arrival is at the auditorium, where you will sign your child in. The remainder of the morning will consist of activities in our school and auditorium; pick-up is 11:00 am in the auditorium. Dress is casual, but we ask that children wear clothing appropriate for church as well as coats etc., as we will be going from building to building for activities.
