SCRIPTURES:

MAY 20th- Pentecost Sunday

First Reading: DURING THE FEAST OF PENTECOST, TONGUES OF FIRE CAME TO REST ON THE HEADS OF THE DISCIPLES AND THEY WERE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT. EACH DISCIPLE BEGAN SPEAKING IN A DIFFERENT LANGUAGE, AND WERE UNDERSTOOD BY PEOPLE FROM MANY DIFFERENT REGIONS WHO WERE AMAZED AT WHAT THEY HAD WITNESSED. (Acts 12: 1-11)

SECOND READING: PAUL EXPLAINS THAT WE ARE ALL MEMBERS OF ONE BODY. WE HAVE ALL BEEN BAPTIZED IN ONE SPIRIT AND ALTHOUGH NUMEROUS, WE ARE ONE THROUGH CHRIST. (1 CORINTHIANS 12: 3B-7, 12-13)

GOSPEL: JOHN DESCRIBES JESUS' FIRST VISIT TO THE DISCIPLES AFTER HIS RESURRECTION. HE GAVE THEM THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE POWER TO FORGIVE OTHER PEOPLE OR HOLD THEM RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS. (JOHN 20: 19-23)

As we celebrate Mother's Day this Sunday, let us take some time to reflect on the important role which Mary holds as Mother of Jesus and Mother of the Church. Mary has been honored by the Church since the earliest days of Christianity. Over the centuries, her name and image have been a source of devotion, reverence and a model of Christian Living.

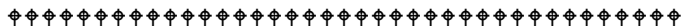
It is in the Gospels that we see Mary as a widow and faithful Mother following her Son's brief ministry to its tragic end on the Cross. Beyond the Resurrection and Ascension, Mary accompanied the frightened apostles as they received the Holy Spirit and the Church is born. It is in these Gospel narratives that we come closest to understanding the true person of Mary. In these humble and faithful incidents, we can find a model for Christian Living.

In her response of faith, Mary gave us an example of how we are asked to respond to God in our own lives. For like her, we also are called to hear the Word of God and act on it in our daily lives. Mary saw the needs of others and did something about them. As Christians we are called to see beyond our own lives and look with compassion on the world in which we live and respond to the needs which we see around us. We live in a busy world – time, work, wants and needs shout loudly; they take their toll on us and our families. Just as in our lives, Mary's faith, trust and courage were tested so often in the everyday experiences of her life. May her example encourage us to be receptive to God's Word and act on it.

On this Mother's Day, may we look to Mary as our Mother and love and honor her as Jesus did. Through her intercession let us pray that all our Mothers may be blessed for all they do for us each and every day of the year.
