## SCRIPTURES

### June 16, 2019 –Most Holy Trinity

**First Reading:** GOD CREATED WISDOM BEFORE HE CREATED THE EARTH OR THE SKIES. THIS SPIRIT STOOD BESIDE GOD EVERY DAY UNTIL THE EARTH WAS COMPLETE, THEN "FOUND DELIGHT IN THE PEOPLE OF THE EARTH." THIS INDICATES THAT THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM WAS LATER PERSONIFIED BY JESUS. (PROVERBS 8: 22-31)

**SECOND READING:** PAUL SAYS THAT WE ARE NOW AT PEACE WITH GOD THROUGH OUR FAITH IN JESUS. WE ALSO HOPE TO SEE THE GLORY OF GOD. THIS HOPE WILL NOT LEAVE US DISAPPOINTED BECAUSE OF THE LOVE GOD HAS SHOWN IN SENDING US THE HOLY SPIRIT. (ROMANS 5: 1-5)

**GOSPEL:** JESUS TELLS THE DISCIPLES THAT WHEN HE LEAVES THEM, A SPIRIT WILL HELP GUIDE THEM TO THE TRUTH. THIS SPIRIT WILL ANNOUNCE WHAT HE HEARS FROM JESUS, RATHER THAN SPEAKING ON HIS OWN. EVERYTHING GOD HAS ALSO BELONGS TO JESUS, WHICH IS WHY THOSE THINGS ANNOUNCED BY THE SPIRIT WILL ACTUALLY COME FROM JESUS. (John 16: 12-15)

# PENTECOST THE BIRTHDAY OF THE CHURCH

Today we celebrate one of our most important feasts-- that of Pentecost. It celebrates **the descent of the Holy Spirit** upon the Apostles and the **birth of the Church**. The second chapter of Acts tells of this event and uses great imagery to describe it-- a powerful wind, tongues of fire, people speaking in many languages, and the joy of the Apostles. It is truly moving. This group of twelve men is transformed into a Community of Faith on fire with zeal to spread the Word of God. Now they understand the true nature of the Death, Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus and the Gift of the Spirit. It is from this small group of disciples that the Church has grown into a worldwide Community of Faith.

The primary meaning of the word Church is not a building where people worship, but a community of people which accepts the Risen Christ in their lives and who gather to share their faith and celebrate His Presence. When we gather we do certain things:

- We recall our past experience of Jesus in Scripture.
- We celebrate His risen and living presence among us through signs and symbols in the Eucharist.
- We then go out to share the Good News of Jesus with others in Ministry.

Jesus promised that He would send His Spirit and that He would remain with us to the end of time. It is this same Spirit who guides the Church today. It is up to us as members of the Community of Faith at Star of the Sea to foster a sense of unity and commitment to living out the Gospel in our lives. **WE ARE THE CHURCH TODAY.**
