## SCRIPTURES:

### September 29th– 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

**First Reading:** AMOS DENOUNCES THE SELFISH ATTITUDE OF THOSE WHO SURROUND THEMSELVES WITH LUXURIES WITH NO CONCERN FOR OTHERS. HE GOES ON TO WARN THAT BECAUSE THESE PEOPLE LACKED INTEREST IN THE STATE OF THEIR SOCIETY, THEY WOULD BE THE FIRST TO BE EXILED. (AMOS 6:1A, 4-7)

**SECOND READING:** PAUL TELLS TIMOTHY TO SEEK INTEGRITY, FAITH, AND LOVE. PAUL URGES HIM TO ATTAIN EVERLASTING LIFE BY MAINTAINING STRONG FAITH IN JESUS AND IN GOD UNTIL JESUS RETURNS. (1 TIMOTHY 6: 11-16)

**GOSPEL:** JESUS TELLS OF A RICH MAN WHO FEASTED DAILY, WHILE A BEGGAR NAMED LAZARUS WENT HUNGRY OUTSIDE HIS GATES. WHEN BOTH MEN DIED, LAZARUS WAS TAKEN TO ABRAHAM, BUT THE RICH MAN WAS IN TORMENT. WHEN HE BEGGED FOR MERCY, ABRAHAM REMINDED HIM THAT LAZARUS HAD LIVED IN TORMENT, WHILE THE RICH MAN LIVED IN SELFISH LUXURY. THE MAN THEN ASKED IF LAZARUS COULD BE SENT TO HIS BROTHERS TO WARN THEM. BUT ABRAHAM SAID IF THEY HAD NOT HEADED MOSES OR THE PROPHETS, THEY WOULD IGNORE EVEN THE WARNING OF ONE RISEN FROM THE DEAD. (LUKE 16: 19-31)

## SPECIAL HONORS FOR EDWARD & MATTIE YOUNG

In 2009 Bishop Serratelli instituted a special honor to recognize Catholics who contribute time and talent to all parishes, schools and diocesan agencies within the Paterson Diocese. This award is called the **Vivere Christus Est Award**. Translated it means **"To Live Is Christ"**. Each year I have nominated at least one individual or married couple to receive this award. This year I nominated Edward & Mattie Young.

Ed coordinates our participation of the Faith Soup Kitchen at Trinity Lutheran Church in Dover with the assistance of his wife Mattie, who also supervises our Garden Ministry. They have two daughters- Kelly & Jennifer-and have been parishioners at Our Lady Star of the Sea since 1989.

Ed's activities with the Soup Kitchen include coordinating TEAMS of parishioners to cook meals, and help serve on the fourth Friday of every month. He also stores all donated items in his garage, sometimes making it impossible to park his own vehicles there. Ed also handles the Winter Coat/Accessories Drive we hold to help the people who use the Soup Kitchen in Dover make it through the cold months.

Mattie has helped to keep our grounds around the Church beautiful for many years. Recently, she has organized a team of volunteers from the parish to help her in this ministry. You can often see her working with the flowers during the week if you come and visit our Church. She also hosts a table at the Craft Fair each year at which she sells hand-painted items to benefit Faith Soup Kitchen in Dover. Mattie is also a member of our Rosary Altar Society.

Both Mattie & Ed assist when our Family Promise Program for the Homeless is in residence.

Edward & Mattie Young received the Vivere Christus Est Award from Bishop Serratelli on Sunday, September 8th at St. John's Cathedral, Paterson. Congratulations to Ed & Mattie Young on receiving this award.

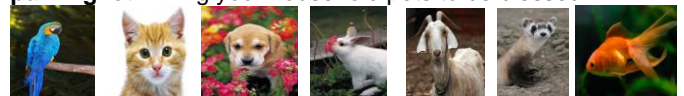
