First Reading: THIS READING IS A SHORT PASSAGE FROM THE SECOND SONG OF THE SERVANT OF THE LORD. THE LORD WILL SHOW HIS GLORY THROUGH HIS SERVANT WHOSE MISSION IS TO RESTORE ISRAEL AND BRING SALVATION "TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH."

SECOND READING: PAUL SENDS GREETINGS TO THE PEOPLE OF CORINTH, WHO HAVE BEEN CALLED TO BE HOLY AND CONSECRATED IN CHRIST.

THE BAPTISM OF JESUS

On this day the Christmas Season comes to an end. We have walked with Mary through the touching and loving days of pregnancy. We have yearned with Israel of old for the coming of the Messiah and we have celebrated the Lord's birth at Bethlehem. Every day as we have read and prayed over the Scriptures, we have been anointed by the Holy Spirit to understand another aspect of the Lord's personal and redeeming love for us.

Today, at the River Jordan, the ministry of Jesus as well as our own ministry begins. The Father speaks the words of consecration over Jesus and over each of us. Matthew, Mark and Luke have the Father saying that "This is my beloved Son (Daughter) upon whom my favor rests."

Each of us must know that the Father does speak these words of anointing over each of us. We are His beloved son or daughter. His favor and blessing does rest upon us. We have invited Him into our hearts. We have given Him our sins and brokenness and we are certain of His complete and total forgiveness. We have embraced Him as our Lord and Savior. The process of our transformation is not complete yet. But when a son or daughter truly wishes to live the new and abundant life and truly accepts Jesus as Lord and begins the journey, then the Father sings a song of joy declaring us to be His Beloved Children upon whom His pleasure, love and favor rest forever.

This favor of the Father that we experience does not mean that we're perfect or that we will never fall or make mistakes again. It means that we are on the right road and that all we have to do when we stumble is to take His hand and let Him draw us to Himself again.

We are His precious and beautiful saints. But what is a saint? Someone who is perfect and has never sinned? No! A saint is a sinner who never gives up. Remember, each saint has a past and every sinner has a future with Jesus. What this holy season has reminded us again is of the promise of the Father's love for us incarnate in the Child of Bethlehem. Now we continue the Incarnation as we are the flesh and blood of Jesus Christ to one another. In our love and fidelity Christmas will last forever.

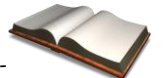
