

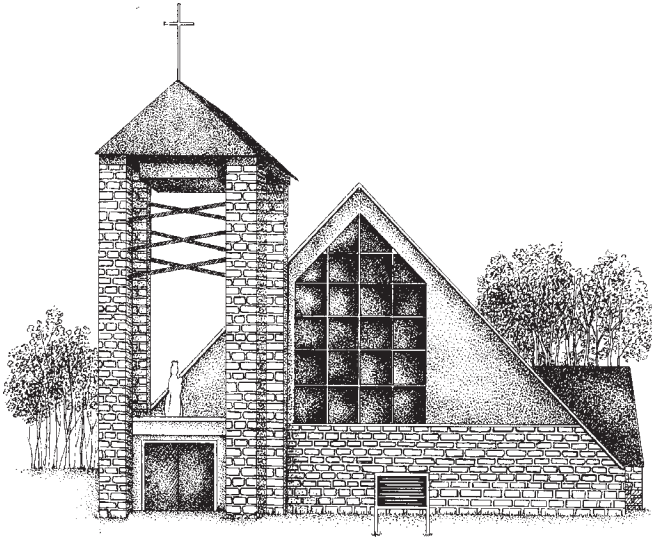

#### 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time October 24, 2021

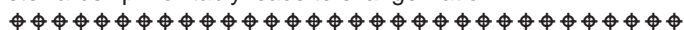
**First Reading:** Jeremiah speaks of God reuniting the people of Israel after their exile. He states that although they departed in tears, God will lead them all back and protect them, because He is Father to Israel. **(Jeremiah 31:7-9)**

**Second Reading:** Each high priest is taken from among people and offers sacrifices for their sins. High priests do not choose to take on this honor, but are chosen by God. Even Christ did not choose this office, but was chosen by God to be a priest forever. **(Hebrews 5:1-6)**

**GOSPEL:** A blind beggar approached Jesus and pleaded that Jesus heal him. Jesus called the man over and said, "Your faith has healed you." The man immediately received his sight and proceeded to follow Jesus up the road. **(Mark 10:46-52)**

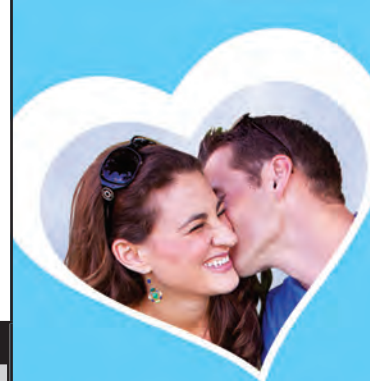
