THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: A scriptural passage from the Letter to the Hebrews reads as follows "Strive for peace with all men and for the holiness without which not one will see the Lord." Hebrews 12:14) It is always a temptation for us to say "if I don't sin too bad, I will get to heaven." God does not just call us to live good lives. He calls us to live holy lives, which requires that we ask ourselves what it means to be holy. First and foremost, holiness requires a relationship with God. Holiness requires that we love God and express that love by putting God first in our lives. It also requires that our love for God springs over into a love for others. Love for God, or for others, is not an emotional love. This love resides in our wills--in our decision to place God first in our lives. If God is first in our lives, we will then love the people that God loves. Love for God does not happen in an instant. It is something that must grow within us. That is why prayer and the reception of the Sacraments are so important. Through prayer and the Sacraments, we open our hearts to God asking that he place a true love for Him with us. It is very appropriate to ask God to give us an authentic love for Him and a true love for others. Since all love comes from God, we must beg God to fill us with love. Our begging for the gift of love does not change God. Instead, it deepens our capacity to receive the gift of love.
