THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: Why pray for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit? To answer that question it helps to remember some of the rich biblical images. St. Paul teaches us that we are the Body of Christ. In the Gospel of St. John, we are told that we are the branches and Jesus is the vine. If we are to live and function as the Body of Christ, we need a life force, a Spirit, that is greater than our spirit. We need the life that comes to us through the vine who is the Lord Jesus. The task that is ours as members of the Church, the Body of Christ, is to continue the saving work of Christ. The Gospel for this Sunday, the Solemnity of the Ascension, reminds us that we are to make disciples of all nations. None of us have the power to make disciples. For someone to make the decision to mold their life according to the pattern of the life of Jesus is a decision that can only be motivated by a power greater than our limited human capacity. We need the Holy Spirit to enter in and touch the hearts of others so that they may have the desire to follow Christ and to be transformed into his image. We pray, therefore, for the gift of the Holy Spirit to be poured out upon the world. We pray first of all for ourselves, so that we can become true disciples. Secondly, we pray that the spirit may work through us to bring others to discipleship. As we approach the feast of Pentecost, let us pray for a powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the whole world. The Holy Hours scheduled for the Eve of Pentecost are for the purpose of praying for this outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Please join in with your fellow Christians in this time of prayer.
