THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: Several years ago I attended a workshop about how we use our time. One distinction that has stayed with me is the distinction between what is urgent and what is important. Unfortunately, we often focus on the urgent and postpone the important things in our lives. It may be urgent to get the shopping done; to get a birthday card in the mail; to get to the children's ball game on time or to keep the appointment with the barber or hair dresser. However, it is far more important that we take time to listen to the people we love; that we give our attention to someone who is hurting; that we take time to nurture our relationship with God. I suspect the lives of all of us would be happier and we would feel less pressured if we focused less on the urgent things of our daily living and spent more of our attention on those things that are truly important. It might be helpful if, before each day is over, we were to look back over the day to ask ourselves which events of the day were truly important and then to ask ourselves if our day was dominated by the important tasks or the urgent tasks.
