THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: With some frequency, we hear the word "adoption" or "adopted" in the Scripture readings for Mass or in the Mass prayers. We might easily overlook the word not knowing for sure what is meant. The concept of being adopted children of God merits some reflection. We see the word "adoption" in the second reading for this Sunday, Trinity Sunday. The concept is trying to bring home to us the deep spiritual truth that we have become so much one with Jesus Christ through Baptism that we share, by adoption, in the very sonship of Jesus Christ. The spiritual fathers of the early Church used a phrase: "What Jesus is by nature, Son of God, we have become by adoption." In union with Christ Jesus, God has adopted us. By adoption, God has made us His sons and daughters. In virtue of this, we share the inheritance of Christ. We are called to share eternally in His life of intimate love with the Father. The only thing that can stand in the way of sharing in this life of love is to choose a life of unbelief or of sin. As long as we live in Christ, we are assured of eternal union with God in the Kingdom of Heaven.

<u>DIOCESAN SUMMER YOUTH CAMP:</u> From Youth Director, Adam Urban: I want to update you on the status of camp, and give you information in regards to the 7th and 8th grade session. Unfortunately we did not receive enough 7th and 8th grade registrations, so we will have to combine both camps. This means that Camp Cristo Rey will consist of 5th – 8th grade. We realize this is not ideal on several levels. Middle school is a crucial time of development spiritually, emotionally, and physically, and even one year greatly impacts the maturity level of students. However, due to only 6 registrations for 7th and 8th grade currently, this is the best solution.

Because of this, we are offering an extension to the camp that will run from Sunday June 10th at 4:00 pm to Thursday June 14th at 10:00 am for all campers. We want to give each student the optimal camping experience because we have combined 5th through 8th grade. This allows the staff more time to appropriately interact with a diverse age group. Although we have combined the age groups, registration is still open until May 28th. Currently we have 41 total registrations which is exciting! Parents can still register their children at https://www.dcyouth.org/camp-cristorey. The youth office budget is supported in part by the parishes and their Parish Stewardship Contributions as well as through the Vibrant Ministries Appeal - Alms in Action, and any additional expense for the extended time will be absorbed by the youth office budget.

This is an optional extension for 5th & 6th graders, and if your child is unable to stay longer than the initial Tuesday evening departure this is understandable. If you will still be picking up your child on Tuesday at 5:00 pm please let us know.

If you have registered a 7th & 8th grader and they will not be able to attend the new schedule, please let us know so that we can refund your money.
