THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: *The following is a quote from the Fall 2018 CARA [Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate] Report . CARA is a national, non-profit, Georgetown University affiliated research center that conduct social scientific studies about the Catholic Church. Founded in 1964, CARA has three major dimensions to its mission: to increase the Church's self understanding; to serve the applied research needs of Church decision-makers; to advance scholarly research on religion, particularly Catholicism.
