THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: This past week has given us more reminders of the moral deterioration that is going on around us. New York state has made abortion legal for all nine months of pregnancy. Legislation was also being debated in the state of Virginia that would allow a baby to be aborted even after the mother was in the process of giving birth. The Governor of Virginia was interviewed supporting the idea that a baby's life could be terminated even after birth if the mother desired and if two physicians agreed that there was cause for such an action. As the pro-abortion forces face the possibility that changes in the Supreme Court could reverse the Roe v Wade decision, they are working to place permissive abortion laws in the various states so that the right to abortion can be maintained. I encourage everyone to actively pray that this work of the devil can be overcome and that people supporting such extreme legislation will have a conversion of heart. These incidents also show us the importance of our voting our values when we have the opportunity to vote.
