THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED:. Last week I promised to share more ideas on helping to better understand the Mass. My suggestion for this week is to borrow a copy of the hymnal or missalette from the church and read the Eucharistic Prayers (the prayers that follow the Holy, Holy). There are four different prayers that you will find in the booklets. Read each one slowly noticing what the prayer is conveying. Notice that the Eucharistic Prayers are always addressed to God the Father and that there is a petition that, through the working of the Holy Spirit, the meager gifts we offer of bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. The prayer of consecration for each of the Eucharistic Prayers is the same; always a repetition of the words of Jesus at the Last Supper. Each of the prayers conveys the reality that we are offering to the Father the sacrifice of Jesus, His Son, that was accomplished upon the cross. Eucharistic Prayer I expresses this reality with the following words "...this pure victim, this holy victim, this spotless victim, the holy Bread of eternal life and the Chalice of everlasting salvation." Prayer III states: "we offer you in thanksgiving this holy and living sacrifice". Referring to Jesus, the Prayer III speaks of "the sacrificial Victim." Several of the prayers also bring out the petition that we who receive the gift of the Eucharist truly become "...one body, one spirit in Christ." Not only do we offer the Sacrifice of Jesus on the cross, but we also offer ourselves to God in union with Christ. Fr. Ted Skalsky
