### MUSINGS OF FATHER JIM: Dear parishioners,

The fall of temperatures, announcing the coming of Fall, is only bitterer that the promised end of the spread of the Covid-19 virus did not come with the summer heat. We still are under the protocol of May 17th in our diocese, except for the localizing of the decision to allow use of our halls, and the following of the CDC guidelines for serving food. Our initiating of religious formation is following basically the protocol of the school districts. We have not instituted screening of the children, that is temperature checks at the doors, but are trying to maintain mask use, distancing and disinfection that is recommended. If your child is sick, that is not feeling well or running a temperature, please do not send them to religious formation. We will recognize these as excused absences and will not be accorded to the allowance of only 3 absences for those who are preparing to receive sacraments.

I have set the dates for the October parish missions, October 11-14th for Meade, October 18-22nd for Plains, and October 25 through 28th at Fowler. Mark your calendars for the whole family. Fowler will start a half hour later at 7:30 PM, but the retreat days will be identical, so if you can't make one day, there is the option at the other parishes. Because of the Covid Virus restraints, I still am undecided about a social refreshment break or a parish meal on the last day. These are traditionally an enjoyable and important part of parish gatherings, but in this time, it is unwieldy, plus we will hold the retreat in the churches where we can maintain social distancing. Any thoughts?

Our renewal in the mission of the Church is a perennial need for our faith and this opportunity will use the modern media of the digital series on DVD from Bishop Robert Barron of the Word on Fire Institute entitled the Sacraments to bring his virtual presence for our retreat. Monday and Tuesday nights will be a bit longer. Mass will be celebrated to end each night of the mission. I will offer the mission in Spanish November 8th through the 12th at St. Patrick's in Plains.

Our mission is a bit more difficult but even more essential in the tumultuous times we live. Please join the daily rosary to the election on Nov. 3rd, praying for our country and world and join in these coming special days of prayer and reflection.
