MUSINGS OF FATHER JIM: Dear people still under the Pandemic cloud,

It's officially in the works, "Apostolic Administrator Gerald Vincke has announced the dispensation from attending Mass will be lifted on Pentecost weekend, which is May 22 to 23, in the Diocese of Dodge City. The dispensation will still be in place for the elderly, those who are immune-compromised, those who are sick, etc. Apostolic Administrator Vincke is writing a pastoral letter on the importance of attending Sunday Mass."

I think we have moved very close to our full attendance levels, though a few families have continued to stay away. I fear with all of the clergy, that this may become a permanent disassociation from the practice of the faith. We mostly have been able to accommodate our congregations with the 50% capacity of closed pews. The recommendation of the county nurse has been to maintain masking as long as possible, and encouraging social distancing voluntarily.

Unfortunately, after weeks of no active cases, the health department is reporting today five active cases of the Coronavirus in our County, focused mainly in Meade and involving the County Hospital. This has dampened my enthusiasm for removing the Coronavirus precautions. I am going ahead with the addition of automatic holy water dispensers. We will continue with voluntary distancing and masks for the time being, but will gradually begin removing the ropes, leaving them in the back few pews for those who choose to practice social distancing.

Fr. Klein, last week quoted Karen Armstrong, a theologian and author. "I practice religion to find my meaning in life and I can only do that with others, (through the Sacred Assembly)." The Mass is a public work that we do together. The Mass is a sacrificial offering to the Glory of God that restores us to communion. It is the necessary food from heaven. Our Administrator, Bishop Vincke will be sending a pastoral letter in this vein in the next few weeks to restore our confidence and commitment to the Eucharist.

We need to be healed and the beauty of our liturgy to be restored. I have struggled recently to keep live streaming of the Mass, having substitute priests and technical difficulties. Rather than investing more in equipment and management of live streaming, I will discontinue the live streaming of the Sunday Eucharist on Pentecost, as well as restoring the offertory and the procession of gifts at that time. These remaining weeks, I will try to return the Masses' weekly presence on Facebook for the few weeks that remain before Pentecost.
