Marriage Preparation: Jason Kidd, Director of Marriage and Family Life for the Archdiocese of Portland, video-conferenced with the council. He explained the Archdiocese's recommended steps for marriage preparation. The below information comes from:

Steps to Preparing Well for the Sacrament of Matrimony:

- **Continue to pray & discern** if you are ready for this life long decision to share life together. It's recommended to take a full 9 months to prepare for your marriage, as research shows this increases your chance for a life long marriage.
- **Contact your parish** to begin the preparation process (at least 6 Months before your wedding).
- Go through the 6 Elements of Marriage Preparation:
- 1. Welcome & Intake (parish connection and forms)
- 2. Relationship Inventory (Snapshot of your relationship like *Prepare and Enrich*)
- 3. Inventory Review & Relationship Tools
- 4. Sacramental & Spiritual Matrimony
- 5. Sponsor Couples
- 6. Follow Up Post Wedding

After walking us through the website and discussing the elements listed above, Jason answered questions.

Couples preparing for marriage at St. Paul's are directed to the Father Bernard Youth Center. The marriage prep program there follows the Archdiocese's program with the exception of paperwork, interview and sponsor couple support. Father Basil completes our paperwork and conducts the interview so he can get to know the couple better. The council thought having a sponsor couple (couple married and active in the Catholic church) follow and support the engaged couple would be a good addition to the program at FBYC.

The next Marriage Preparation Program at FBYC begins October 3rd.

A Tribunal will meet October 28^{th} to answer questions regarding how to get a marriage regularized. Information will be available in English and Spanish.
