



HCCA Tuition, Fees, and Miscellaneous Payment Policy 2020-2021

Registration Fee:

- \$500.00 per student
- \$700.00 International Student

Early Registration Fee: (Non-International Students)

- \$300.00 if enrolled by March 31st
- \$400.00 if enrolled by April 30th

Full payment of the registration fee is required before student is officially enrolled. Payment can be made in the office or online at <https://www.holycrossama.org/make-a-payment>. An online fee of 3% will be added if paying online.

Required School Insurance: The policy provides \$25,000 medical and \$25,000 life insurance. The average cost per student is \$21.00 and is included in the registration fee.

FACTS: FACTS is the school management program that allows family access to daily attendance, daily grades and assignments, progress report and report card grades. This annual cost is \$40 per student, which covers the yearly school fee paid by HCCA and is included in the registration fee.

Book Fee: Online access for certain textbooks is included in the registration fee.

Organizational Memberships: Fee is included in the registration fee.

Athletic Fees: Fees are used for coaching stipends, transportation, athletic director stipend, officials, facilities, etc. The athletic fee for each sport is to be paid in full before the first scheduled game, tournament or meet.

Senior Graduation Fee: The graduation fee of \$125.00 is for seniors only and covers the cost of the graduation expenses, the diploma and cover, and cap and gown. The fee does not cover the cost of senior rings and graduation invitations. Payment for this fee is due by March 1st.

Fundraising: The fundraising fee is \$1000 per family. If a family fails to earn the required \$1000 with fundraising, the balance is added to the family's FACTS account. A family may decide to pay \$1000 in August, 2 payments of \$500 in August and January or pay monthly through FACTS. The fundraising fee may also be added to the monthly tuition fees through FACTS.

Service Hours: The tuition does not begin to cover the total cost of educating each student. Since hours are a necessary and integral part of keeping tuition at a reasonable level and keeping the school operating within its budget. Each family is required to work 30 hours at \$25.00 per hour. If registration is paid in full before March 31st and tuition contract signed, the number of required service hours will be reduced to 20 hours. Each un-worked hour will be billed at \$25.00 per hour and due the last statement for the school year.

Tuition: The tuition is the same for all students 6th-12th. There is an \$800.00 Deanery Scholarship for each Catholic student whose family is a registered and active member of a parish. A completed verification of registration form is required to receive this scholarship. There are tuition discounts for multiple-student families. Monthly, quarterly, and bi-annual tuition payments are paid through FACTS, an online tuition-collecting program. There is a yearly fee of \$45.00 payable to FACTS with finalization and activation in May.

The total cost to educate one student at Holy Cross Catholic Academy is \$10,500. Fundraising is a huge component that decreases the cost of tuition. Families have the option to pay the \$1,000 fundraising fee with their tuition or they can opt to participate in our two fundraisers. The Calendar Party is held in August and the Catholic Life Insurance Raffle begins in November through January.

The Mustang Scholarship (need-based assistance): The scholarship must be applied for through the Diocese of Amarillo. Qualified families can receive up to 50% assistance on tuition. There is a limited amount of funds available and it is given on a first come, most needed basis. There is a one-time \$30.00 fee for the application payable to FACTS.
